




Hostel Day

Awareness Session of POCSO and Child Abuse

Advocate Rutuja Palaspagar led a session on addressing physical violence against children in the society on 9th December, 2024. During the session, the focus was on discussing strategies for safeguarding children well-being in their daily lives, using drama as a tool. Advocate Palaspagar elaborated on the concepts of good touch and bad touch, and through dramatic enactment, illustrated appropriate responses in case of such incidents. The session also covered an introduction to the POCSO Act, which safeguards the rights of children as guaranteed by Article 21 of the Indian Constitution and the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child. Prior to the enactment of the POCSO Act, the Goa Child Act, 2003, served as the primary legislation addressing child abuse. The session was attended by over 50 students from the coaching class, split into two groups.



Bible Study

Every Saturday at 7:30 am, a consistent Bible study session takes place, offering a dedicated opportunity for individuals to nurture their spiritual growth and delve into biblical teachings. Spearheaded by Rosh Zacheria, who serves as the facilitator, these sessions are well-received, attracting participants eager to engage with the Word of God. The sessions are structured to cover various topics and passages, aiming to provide a comprehensive grasp of the Bible. Typically, the format involves reading specific passages, group discussions, and reflections on the practical application of biblical teachings in daily life.
